1 LEARN THE LICENSING REQUIREMENTS IN YOUR STATE

Licensing requirements vary by state, and in a few rare instances by city or county. Knowing if you are required to obtain a license, and what is needed to do so is the very first step. **Click here** for info on training requirements in your state or visit:

2. HONESTLY EVALUATE YOUR KNOWLEDGE AND SKILLS

Take an honest valuation of yourself. As a qualified home inspector, you will be responsible for determining the safety and quality of all aspects of a home from foundation to roof. You will need to have a thorough understanding of how homes are built and maintained.

Although most inspectors start out with experience in construction, it is not required. People from all backgrounds have become successful home inspectors after completing our training. If you are willing to work hard and to learn, you too can become a fruitful home inspector.

3 EVALUATE YOUR BUSINESS AND CUSTOMER SERVICE SKILLS

6. DETERMINE HOW YOU WILL OBTAIN WORK

There are several ways you can begin inspecting. You can work for someone else, start your own business, or purchase a franchise. Let's look at some of the pros and cons of each.

Working for an existing inspection firm

This is the easiest way to get started—lower start-up costs and you'll have access to an existing base of clients. The downside is you'll make less money and you may be stuck paying for licensing fees, tools, a vehicle and insurance anyway.


Starting your own inspection firm

You'll control every aspect of your company. Do 7 inspections a week at \$350 a pop and make six figures. Hire a couple inspectors and blow up.

Of course, the initial investment is steep, and it's hard work. But if you weren't willing to work hard, you'd never be reading this...

Purchasing a franchise

When you purchase a franchise, you buy a business that can start making money immediately. You'd own an existing brand with established marketing and business relationships. The downfall is the steep up-front cost of \$30-\$50k. The franchise may want a percentage of your annual profits.



7. NEVER STOP LEARNING AND ADDING CERTIFICATIONS TO YOUR OFFERINGS

The more you know, the more you can offer and the more you will earn. As in any career, it pays to stay current and continually educate yourself with skills to remain competitive. As you add more certifications, you can add more inspection offerings such as; radon, mold, WDO, pools and spas, thermal imaging, lead, etc. The more educated you are, the more you will have to offer and stand out from your competition.



Frequently Asked Questions

How much money will I make?

Your earning potential is set by you! The more inspections you do, the more you will make. On a national average, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, the average inspector earns around \$57,000 per year.

Do I need previous experience?

While prior experience in a trade related industry is helpful, it is not necessary. We will train you on everything you need to know to conduct a thorough and professional home inspector.

Why should I become a home inspector?

Becoming a home inspector allows you to take control of your life. You get to set your own schedule and control your income. Unlike other trade related industries, home inspecting is less strenuous on your body.

Do I need to get on a roof?

YES! Whenever possible it is best practice to get on the roof to inspect it. If you cannot go on to a roof due to weather or safety conditions, try to view the roof from the ladder or with binoculars.

What add-ons can I sell?

After you become a qualified and certified home inspector, you can begin to train in add-ons to offer such as: radon testing, mold, termites, and pools and spas.

How much does training cost?




